

How to Follow the Los Angeles Chargers From Out of Market (2026)

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The Chargers beat you left behind

Start here, because this is the half no streaming package sells you. On an ordinary Tuesday in Los Angeles, the Chargers story is being worked by Los Angeles Times, Orange County Register, NBC LA and ABC7 Los Angeles. Add the club's own newsroom at chargers.com and that is 5 separate mastheads filing on one team, most of them on days when nothing has officially happened.

Los Angeles carries two NFL teams, so those same desks split the week between the Chargers and the Rams. Pulling the Chargers thread out of a shared market is work enough in town, and close to impossible from another state. None of it was built for you. It was built for the people who still live in Los Angeles, which is why moving away quietly costs you the practice report, the Friday injury designation and the beat writer's read on why the AFC West game actually

turned. [Vurvo](#) puts every one of those sources, plus the Chargers podcasts and YouTube shows, into one free feed, in your team's colors.

How to watch Chargers games out of market

The national windows follow you anywhere: Thursday, Sunday and Monday night, plus any Chargers game flexed into a national slot. What you lose by moving is the ordinary Sunday afternoon game that only clears the Los Angeles market. **NFL Sunday Ticket** on YouTube and YouTube TV is the out-of-market answer to exactly that, which for a displaced fan means most of the Chargers schedule, the AFC West dates against the Broncos, Chiefs and Raiders included. **RedZone** rides along on Sundays, **NFL+** adds out-of-market preseason, and **Game Pass on DAZN** covers you outside the US. Rights packages move season to season, so check the current lineup before you buy.

Or watch with other Chargers fans

The other answer to a Sunday away from Los Angeles is a room full of people dressed in your team's colors. Most big cities have one bar that has quietly become the Chargers bar, and displaced fans find each other there long before they find each other anywhere else. [Go For GameDay](#) searches by team and ZIP nationwide; [Watch Party Radar](#) lists them city by city:

Neither directory is ours and neither covers every town. If yours is missing, the Chargers supporters' groups are the fastest way in: they booked the bar, usually years before any directory noticed.

Hearing the Los Angeles call from another state

The national TV crew is not the crew you grew up on. **NFL+** carries live game audio for every game, Chargers home call included, from anywhere in the US, and the Los Angeles flagship usually streams its own broadcast through the club's app on game day where local rights allow. Radio in one ear, muted TV feed in the other, the way Los Angeles has always done it.

Following the Chargers between Sundays

Out of market mostly means late. The trade breaks on a Los Angeles station you cannot pick up, and you hear about it three hours behind the people you would normally argue with. [Vurvo](#) pushes Chargers news the moment any of those 5 sources files it, tracks every game live play by

play, and keeps the AFC West race in front of you, in your team's colors, whatever time zone you ended up in.

Displaced Chargers fan FAQ

Which Los Angeles outlets still cover the Chargers every day?

Los Angeles Times, Orange County Register, NBC LA and ABC7 Los Angeles, plus the club's own newsroom at [chargers.com](https://www.chargers.com). That is 5 separate mastheads on one team, and not one of them publishes to the place you moved to. Vurvo pulls all of them into a single Chargers feed.

How can I watch Chargers games if I don't live in Los Angeles?

The national windows air everywhere. For the Sunday-afternoon Chargers games that only clear the Los Angeles market, NFL Sunday Ticket on YouTube and YouTube TV carries the out-of-market feed, which for a displaced fan covers most of the schedule including the AFC West dates against the Broncos, Chiefs and Raiders.

How can I hear the Chargers radio call from another state?

NFL+ carries live game audio for every game, Chargers home call included, from anywhere in the US. The Los Angeles flagship also streams its own broadcast through the club's app on game day where local rights allow, so you are not stuck with the national crew.

Is there one place to follow the Chargers from out of market?

That is what Vurvo is built for. Pick the Chargers once and everything from Los Angeles Times, Orange County Register and the rest of the Los Angeles beat lands in one free feed, with live scores and push alerts the moment news breaks.
